

EDITOR'S NOTE

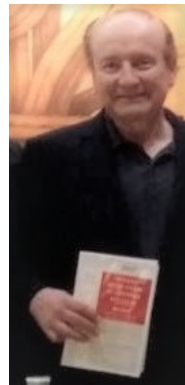
With this issue 12.3 we begin the seventh year of the REMEF. We have achieved one year with our quarterly edition, thus doubling the number of articles published by our collaborators.
